Crystal Wong is currently completing a BA(Hons) Music degree at the School of Contemporary Music at the LASALLE College of the Arts in Singapore. She is being trained as a vocalist in Popular Music.

She spent her teen years performing with her church's Youth Choir. In addition to regular performances during church services, the choir also toured different countries like Cambodia in 2013, Malaysia in 2014, and the Philippines in 2015. Crystal contributed as a choir leader who helped to organize events, lead sectionals when needed, and play guitar accompaniment for performances.

Crystal was also a part of her church's Youth Worship Band and Orchestra. In the band, she was mainly a vocalist but filled in on guitar and drums when needed. In the orchestra, Crystal played percussion and soon became the percussion section leader. She played various percussive instruments such as the glockenspiel, timpani, djembe, and congas.

The turning point in Crystal's life was when her friend asked her for a guitar lesson. Her friend's brother, who has Down Syndrome, joined the class, and Crystal realised then that she wanted to pursue music therapy for those with special needs.

Crystal completed a Diploma in Child Psychology before her time at LASALLE and was able to shadow a music therapist during her final internship at Ngee Ann Polytechnic.

Since starting at LASALLE, she has found a love for songwriting. In addition to writing her own songs and performing regularly, she has also collaborated with various classmates to help them with their original work. Crystal has also been able to experiment with different genres in her original music. While she is not set on a particular genre, Crystal aims to create an environment for those around her to have fun and be authentic both onstage and off.

This year, she formed a band with a group of her classmates. They are a new four-piece pop band called Cosmical. After LASALLE, Crystal will be doing her Master's in Music Therapy in Australia and will return to Singapore to start her own inclusive music school.
